
How To Install






1.Installation of deadbolt

Check the "UP" arrow



2.Installation of exterior plate


The wire is routed below the flat rod



3.Installation of interior plate

The flat rod must be vertical.

Tighten the iron plate screw "J".




4.Left/Right hand open/

Knob position when unlocked



5.Secure the interior plate

Tighten the "K" and "M" screws

Ensure that the wires is connected between the interior and exterior plates.



6.Install battery

It is recommended to use ordinary alkaline batteries or lithium iron batteries, which are more durable, eco-friendly, and safe.

The Lock Ways

1. Key
2. Knob
3. Long press “#” on Keypad
4. Auto lock(optional, config in lock's setting page [automatic lock switch])

* Can't work when unlock by key or knob

Usage Scenario

A.When you enter the door

- 1.Password unlock
- 2.Bluetooth App unlock *

B.When you go out

- 1.Long press “#”
- 2.Bluetooth App lock *
- 3.Auto lock

C.When someone comes

- 1.Turn the knob to unlock
- 2.Bluetooth App unlock *

D.When someone needs a single unlock

- 1.Set in App, slide to obtain dynamic password *

E.You are the landlord or you want to share the permission

- 1.Check the member management in app and add members

F.You no longer use this lock, and others use your lock

- 1.No need to reset, in app main page, press and hold to remove the device

*Please make sure your phone's Bluetooth is connected to the device.
